Information for bus drivers in winter driving conditions

In high mountain regions, winter road conditions are possible even in summer. Austrian law requires winter tires only on the drive axle in winter conditions.

However, according to safety experts, winter tires only on the drive axle are insufficient on sharp bends (hairpin bends), as is the case on the Grossglockner High Alpine Road. For safety reasons, winter tires are also required on the front axle (or snow chains) here. For safety reasons, our ticket office staff may therefore refuse entry to vehicles without appropriate winter tires or snow chains.

Due to the rapidly changing conditions in the high mountains, the traffic information on the website may sometimes be out of date. Therefore, the final decision on whether a vehicle can drive on the Grossglockner High Alpine Road lies with the GROHAG safety officers, who in turn inform the ticket office.

In the interests of safety and orderly procedures, the instructions of our staff (ticket office staff and road service) must be followed at all times!
