Dear Bikers,

Welcome to the Grossglockner High Alpine Road.

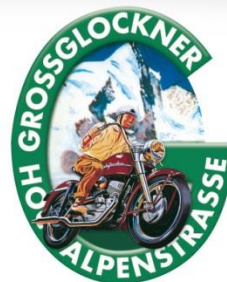
Here are some safety tips on how to demonstrate your respect for other road users and the environment:

- You are using a high alpine road.
Drive at a reasonable, reduced speed.
- Ensure a sense of security for oncoming drivers, especially when passing.
- Unexpected conditions (frozen melt water, wildlife or rocks on the road, sudden fog, etc.) can arise at any time in the mountains.
Always drive „on sight.“
- Be careful in curves and hairpin bends;
buses and trucks have „blind spots.“
- Stay on the right lane, also in left curves
(do not cut curves).
- You are driving through the Hohe Tauern
National Park – please avoid unnecessary noise.
